## Moulinex launches the first food processor with a brain

It also has a standard variable speed control with pulse action for times when you want to take control. So whether you want to pulse your food, speed it up or slow it down you can feel safe in the knowledge that with one push of a button the **Odacio 7** will get the job done.

The **Odacio 7**, with new and improved feet to offer maximum stability, also comes with the range's signature Clip System, making the handles easy to remove and clean. The processor bowl and liquidiser can be positioned in one action, for fast and secure use. And, no need to worry about storage as the tool storage cage holds the bowl and removable handles, and there's cord storage in the base of the unit.

Odacio 7 comes with a variety of other must-have features and accessories for enthusiastic cooks:

- 3 litre processor bowl with safety lid
- 1.5 litre liquidiser jug with safety lid
- Attachment control pad with pre-programmed buttons
- Variable speed action with pulse button
- 800 watts power
- Dishwasher safe storage cage which sits in the bowl
- Cord storage
- Accessories include: mini chopper, citrus press attachment, centrifugal juicer, stainless steel chopping blade, 4 snap-in discs for grating and slicing, snap-in chipping disc, dough blade, metal balloon whisk and spatula.
